PURPOSE OF SPECIALIST MEDICAL REPORTS

A specialist medical report is a comprehensive written report supplemented with photos detailing your injury and permanent disability.

These type of reports are used commonly in disability assessment and compensation claims.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED

- Identification Card (IC) or Passport
- Initial Medical Report(s)
- Medical Imaging (X-Rays, MRI, etc.)*

*attorneys are to submit medical imagings (if any)prior to the examination date.

PROCESS FLOW OF SPECIALIST EXAMINATION

Each patient who undergoes a specialist report examination will go through several processes:

1. REGISTRATION

You are required to register yourself at the registration counter to get a queue number.

2. INTERVIEW

You will be interviewed regarding the nature and circumstances of accident.

3. X-RAY EXAMINATION

You will undergo a detailed X-ray examination to diagnose your bone condition/disease.

4. SPECIALIST EXAMINATION

You will be thoroughly assessed by the attending specialist for your musculoskeletal condition/injury.

5. MEDICAL PHOTOGRAPHY

You will undergo a photography session whereby, pictures of the body parts such as deformities, scarring and range of motion of your limbs will be taken.

You are advised to bring or wear a pair of shorts throughout the medical examination (for lower limb examination).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

You must be present at the designated clinic on the appointed date and time as all examinations will be done on the same day itself. The specialist examination process takes approximately 1-3 hours.

Patients with critical conditions will be given priorities.

You are allowed to go out for breaks while waiting for your examination. However, you are to report your whereabouts to the staff on duty.

Medical Certificate (MC) will be given upon request.

You are not encouraged to bring valuables as we will not be held responsible for any claims, damages or losses.

If you are unable to attend the scheduled examination appointment, you are required to inform your attorney and a new examination appointment will be scheduled.
